Remember: If your basement becomes flooded, do not attempt to go into the basement. Electricity and water make for dangerous conditions.

Important information about standby generators. Cass County Electric Cooperative urges residents to consider the following when purchasing and installing a generator.

- Check to make sure it is sized to carry loads that you wish to operate (sump pump, refrigerator, etc.) Talk to a licensed electrician, store clerk or the engineering department at CCEC about purchasing the right size generator.
- Contact your licensed electrician for proper installation.
 - Make sure the generator is wired in properly to avoid personal injury and damage to the equipment, and to prevent the possibility of putting energy back on the line.
- Remember safety when installing and using a generator.
 - The generator should be connected into a double throw switch or panel.
 - Install generator in a well-ventilated area to prevent carbon monoxide poisoning.
 - When refueling, always turn generator off, allow to cool and then refuel.
