It's that time of year again – winter is just around the corner. Whether we like it or not, it is going to get cold and the snow will come. In order to continue to accommodate your requests for service, we will continue to install service wire in the ground until we are unable to do so. Once the level of firmness reaches a point where we find it difficult to install, we will begin to implement our cold-weather fees. This could take place any time after **November 1st**. Please keep that in mind when planning your construction projects.

Recognizing that everyone is really busy throughout the year, please remember that we need advance notice (2-3 weeks) in order to schedule your electric service. Cold weather charges are \$3/foot from feed point to the meter socket.
